LETTER FROM THE 2022 PROGRAM CHAIR

Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of the CSF Program Committee, it is my sincere pleasure to invite you to the return of our in-person Canadian Surgery Forum (CSF) taking place September 15-17, 2022.

Our schedule will once again see a streamlined structure allowing attendees to follow specific programming related to their desired surgical sub-speciality (general, colorectal, thoracic, hepato-pancreatico-biliary,



surgical oncology, hernia, trauma MIS/endoscopy, rural and resident/medical students). To ensure the cross pollination of specialities, we have created numerous joint symposia between surgical subspecialities focussed on broader topics. This year's CSF will host 12 invited lecturers from Canada and abroad, 8 post-graduate courses (5 of which are hands-on simulation courses) annual events such as our Research Retreat, Women in Surgery Symposium and our paper and poster presentations. Concurrent education symposia will see new topics such as 'Service Models Debates' and 'Ask the Expert' while old favourites return such as 'Alone at Night', 'Difficult Cases' and 'How I do it' video-based sessions. I encourage you to view the 'Program Overview' on pages 8-11 to plan your itinerary.

The theme for this year is Disparities in Canadian Healthcare and the Canadian Association of General Surgeons will be addressing the topic of pay equity in their annual symposium. A White Paper will also be drafted based on the discussions that take place during the session in an attempt to engage stakeholders to enact real change. Related to furthering change, the CSF will be streaming 8 invited lectures free of charge to help further access to medical education both at home and around the globe.

Our industry partners are eager to meet with attendees and provide updates on their research and development over the past 2 years. As such, this year we are pairing sponsored symposia with meal periods (breakfast and lunch) for a more casual learning experience and offering only 3 symposia maximum concurrently to prevent dilution of topics and audiences.

After two years of not being able to meet in person due to COVID-19, we are well aware of the importance of reconnecting with your colleagues and networking. Therefore, we have eliminated almost all business meetings during the CSF to encourage attendees to take in as much education and social events as they can. We are also hosting a Roaring 20's themed CSF Soirée on the Friday evening at Ripley's Aquarium. The evening will capture the feelings of hope and rebirth the world felt emerging out of the 1918 pandemic and First World War.

We are delighted to welcome attendees back in person to the CSF and are confident that Canada's largest surgical meeting will continue to deliver top-notch scientific programming, memorable social experiences and lessons learned from the pandemic to better medical education, research and patient outcomes.

On behalf of the CSF Program Committee, welcome BACK to the in-person CSF and see you in Toronto!

Although CAGS has held an annual meeting since 1977, it was not until 2001, in Quebec City, that the Canadian Surgery Forum (CSF) was born. Today, the major participating surgical societies; CAGS, CSCRS, CATS, CSSO, CHPBA and CHS and minor participating societies; TAC and CON/CABPS work together to organize the largest surgical meeting in Canada. The Canadian Surgery Forum has become the premier surgical conference in Canada for general surgeons to gather, share their experiences and plan new ways to better the needs of their surgical societies.

Conference Goal

To foster communication among surgical subspecialties and to advance continuing professional development, clinical practice, education, research and public advocacy while providing members of the Canadian surgical community an opportunity to meet and network in a collegial fashion.

Conference Objectives

Learn.

To educate delegates through collaborative and quality sessions such as interactive symposia, panel discussions, postgraduate courses, debates, plenary sessions, video sessions and Drinks with the Professor roundtables.

Grow.

To provide surgical societies with accredited continuing professional development and the opportunity for dialogue on educational and research issues.

Unite surgeons and residents and broaden potential networks of interest while unwinding with unique social events such as the Suturing Competition, Surgical Robotics Competition and the CSF Soirée.


