



Vancouver Selected as Host City for the 2023 Canadian Surgery Forum



The Canadian Surgery Forum (CSF) is pleased to announce that the city of Vancouver has been selected to host their 2023 Forum, which will take place from September 21-23, 2023 at the Hyatt Regency Vancouver and the Fairmont Hotel Vancouver. The event was last held in Vancouver in 2014 and was scheduled to return in 2020 but was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
